

MINUTE RECORD FOR CITY OF ALMA
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
May 5, 2025

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Alma, Nebraska was held at City Hall on Wednesday, May 5, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.

Present were Council Members: Tom Moulton, Joel Wheeler, Larry Casper, Dyann Collins, and Mayor Hal Haeker. Absent: None. Administrator Steve Ardiana, City Clerk Janet Dietz, Treasurer Tashia Butterfield, City Utility Superintendent Russ Pfeil, Cody Simmons, and City Attorney Doug Walker were also in attendance. Notification of this meeting and the agenda was given in advance by posting, a designated method for giving notice. Advance notice of the meeting and the agenda was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council. All proceedings hereinafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Haeker advised the public of the Open Meetings Act posted on the east wall of the meeting room, and then proceeded to call the regular meeting of May 5, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. and the following business was transacted:

Roll call: Larry Casper-present, Dyann Collins-present, Tom Moulton-present, Joel Wheeler-present, and Mayor Haeker-present. Motion by Casper, second by Moulton to determine this meeting as previously publicized, duly convened and in open session. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Casper, Moulton, Collins and Wheeler. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to approve the minutes of April 16, 2025, regular council meeting. Motion by Moulton, second by Collins to approve the minutes of April 16, 2025, regular council meeting. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Moulton, Collins, Wheeler, and Casper. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss the claims and invoices for April 17, 2025, through May 5, 2025, for a total of \$ \$168,201.93. Motion made by Moulton, second by Collins to approve the claims. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Moulton, Collins, Wheeler, Casper. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss the Treasurers report. Treasurer Butterfield discussed the interest on the CD's, gas and water usage meeting budget goal, debt service, bond paid for south street, in the amount of \$35,000.00. Motion by Wheeler, second by Moulton to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Wheeler, Moulton, Casper and Collins. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to Library Director Jennifer Roethke. Jennifer brought to the council a request for 2025 Summer Reading Kickoff Party to be held the Alma City Park June 4th, 2025. (between 10 am until 12 noon, parents must remain with their children and must sign a waiver). Jennifer explained to the Council several "messy" painting ideas, around the outside the library, using water soluble paint, wearing glasses, using nontoxic materials, and encouraging family participation. Motion made by Wheeler, second by Casper to approve the Summer reading program in the City Park. There being no further discussion upon the motion made, and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Wheeler, Casper, Moulton, and Collins. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss a request from Alma Berean Church, (Don Ehrke) to hold a church service in the Alma City Park on Sunday July 6th. Discussion moved to cleanup-pickup, potential risk, requiring a permit, also functions in the park being not required permits or July 4th activities. Motion made by Wheeler, second by Moulton to approve. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Wheeler, Moulton, Collins, and Casper. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss Miller & Associates funding opportunities for the lift station. Appropriation funding (Congressionally Directed Spending requests were not allowed this year, Senator Fisher will be prioritizing requests next year.) Nebraska Dept. of Environment and Energy, (NDEE) would offer loan assistance at .7% interest, .7% Admin fee, respectively for 15 years, or shorter. NDEE is currently waiting to see what the Presidents administration direction is. United States Dept. of Agricultural-Rural

Development, (USDA-RD). Alma could apply for a loan to construct the Lift Station, with a fixed rate to be determined by USDA (between 2.50% to 4.25% through June 30th) City would need to complete and submit a Preliminary Engineering Report, to Water Wastewater advisory Committee first. Rural Water Loan, (NRWA) is funded through Rural Utilities Services, United States Dept of Agriculture.(provides short term loans, for repairs) interest rate is currently 3%, payback within 10 years, cost may not exceed, \$200,000, or 75% of the total project cost. A lengthy discussion, (using reserves, increasing utility rates, loans, financing), importance of moving forward with the project. No .decision was made, it was decided to discuss with the CPA Michael Hoback later in the Council meeting.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss the Olson Project, 024-02280 Alma Storm Sewer Hanger, AIP Project 3-31-0004-014, Invoice NO. 530648. (\$18,403.18) for services rendered through April 08, 2025. (design, drilling and geotechnical services). Council reviewed the invoice, motion was made by Wheeler, second by Casper to accept the Olson Project invoice, 024-02280 for \$18,403.18. There being no further discussion upon the motion made, and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Wheeler, Casper , Collins and Moulton. Voting no none. Motion carried.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss the (1) bid from Sorensen Group for mold abatement and structure and demolition in the City Auditorium. (\$163,511.). Council reviewed the project cost, (remove outside existing concrete damaged by drainage system, removal of existing kitchen, existing steps on the east wall behind the kitchen, new sub flooring, mold remediation as needed in the kitchen area, application of antimicrobial solution, north upper wall, removal of benches, removal of plaster, stair demolition, hand and guard rails, north stair demo and installation, basement spray antimicrobial to interior walls.) Motion made by Casper to accept the Sorensen Group bid of \$163,511 for Auditorium mold abatement second by Collins. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon the roll call vote, the following voted yes: Casper, Collins, Wheeler, and Moulton. Voting no none. Motion carried.

Mayor opened the floor to discuss with the CPA Michael Hoback, with Almquist, Galloway and Maltzahn, the annual audit presentation. Michael reviewed printed reports and explained fiscal findings, (balance sheets, assets, liabilities, fund balances, and reserves, department funds, general, street, gas, water, trash, utility rates, revenue expenses, and cash flows). The City has one deficiency with staffing issues, as all small municipalities do, but with the Council remaining diligent and looking over financial reports, claims and invoices, will help with internal controls. Audit findings and corrected journal entry transactions were reviewed. Issues with monitoring utilities cost rates, gas, water and sewer funding operations to provide utility services and necessary improvements. Several members of the Council asked questions regarding the City Sewer Lift Station funding, whether or not the city could self-fund the project. Michael suggested the city utilities could possibly the project fund themselves, using general funds, sinking funds, providing payback to the original fund source. Council thanked Michael for the insight and suggestions.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to City Administrator Steve Ardiana reports, auditorium remodeling , new sewer line, kitchen remodeling, serving window placement, use of attic space, also discussed was lifeguard wages, total employees pool and swim team depositing funds with the Treasure for accountability.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Moulton, second by Casper. There being no further discussion on the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes, Moulton, Casper, Wheeler and Collins. Voting no none, Meeting was adjourned at 7:30 pm .
