March 4, 2024

Hoesch Memorial Library Board of Trustees met on Monday March 4, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. Present were Don Jardon, Bryan Lubeck, Cathy House, Mary Jo Radil, Pam Miller and Keri Anderson Library Director.

Don Jardon called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. with attention given to the Open Meeting Act posted on the conference room wall.

Minutes of the previous meeting February 5, 2024 were read. Motion to approve the minutes as read was made Bryan with second by Mary Jo. Motion carried.

Keri reported that they were waiting to hear if they receive a Circulating Stem Kits Grant, and will be excited to get it. Summer reading books are being ordered. The Friends are helping to fund Early Literacy. We thank them for all of their support. The theme for Summer Reading this year is "Adventures Begin at Your Library." Jennifer is planning a writing workshop for the older elementary and adults for summer reading.
